Ymunodd Sara â Birmingham ym mis Chwefror 2020. Mae ei swydd fel Cyfarwyddwr Cynorthwyol Cyllid a Dirprwy Swyddog Cyllid A.151 wedi canolbwytio ar ddatblygu a chyflawni gweledigaeth 10 mlynedd a model gweithredu targed ar gyfer Cyllid. Mae hyn yn cynnwys gweithredu system ERP, gwella rheolaeth ariannol ar draws y Cyngor a thrawsnewid yr Adran Gyllid yn wasanaeth modern, ystwyth a gwych.

O dan arweinyddiaeth Sara o'r Garfan Cyllid, symudodd Cyngor Dinas Birmingham o sgôr Rheolaeth Ariannol Sefydliad Siartredig Cyllid Cyhoeddus a Chyfrifyddiaeth 1 seren i sgôr 3 seren gan ddyrchafu'r awdurdod lleol i un o'r goreuon yn y DU. Nid yn unig roedd hwn yn gyflawniad sylweddol i Birmingham ond cyflawnwyd y sgôr 3 seren flwyddyn ynghynt na'r disgwyl.

Yn ddiweddar, derbyniodd Sara wobr Canmliaeth Uchel gan Sefydliad Siartredig Cyllid Cyhoeddus a Chyfrifyddiaeth fel Arweinydd Cyllid y Flwyddyn COVID. Roedd hwn yn gyflawniad gwych ac yn gydnabyddiaeth genedlaethol wych o rinweddau arwain Sara. Roedd y Garfan Cyllid hefyd ar y rhestr fer am y gwelliannau sylweddol a wnaed i adroddiadau ariannol yng Nghyngor Dinas Birmingham. Deborah yw Pennaeth Gweithredu Strategaethau Learning Pool, swyddogaeth newydd y mae hi wedi'i chymryd yn ddiweddar ar ôl 8 mlynedd yn Brif Swyddog Gweithrediadau. Mae hi wedi bod yn Learning Pool ers 14 mlynedd ac wedi gweithio gyda chydweithwyr yno i dyfu'r busnes dysgu digidol o'i ddyddiau cychwyn cynnar yn Derry, Gogledd Iwerddon i fod yn fusnes byd-eang o dros 300 o bobl gyda 1,200 o gwsmeriaid ledled y byd.

Dechreuodd Deborah ei gyrfa ym maes cyhoeddi llyfrau addysgol a thros y 30 mlynedd diwethaf mae wedi profi drosti ei hun y newidiadau seismig yn y modd y mae cynnwys dysgu yn cael ei ddylunio, ei baratoi a'i ddefnyddio – o brint ac wyneb yn wyneb, i CD-ROMau, ar-lein a dysgu symudol. Mae Elaine wedi gweithio ei ffordd i fyny o Radd 1 i Bennaeth Gwasanaeth yn ystod ei 35 mlynedd yn gweithio ym maes llywodraeth leol.

Yn ei rôl bresennol, a hithau'n Bennaeth Gweithrediadau TGCh, mae hi'n goruchwyllo 76 aelod o staff ar draws y meysydd canlynol: Desg Gwasanaeth TGCh a Pheirianwyr, Gwasanaethau Technegol (Gwasanaethau Isadeilledd a'r Ganolfan Ddata), Carfan Pecynnau TGCh yn ogystal ag Ymgysylltu â Chwsmeriaid, Rheoli Cyflenwyr a Chyfrifon, Gwasanaethau wedi'u Rheoli gan TGCh a Chontractau Busnes.

Yn 1993, roedd hi'n rhan o'r gwaith o gyflwyno System SIMS i ysgolion ar draws hen ardal Cyngor Morgannwg Ganol.

Mae Elaine wedi cynrychioli RhCT, gan lywio esblygiad Rhaglen Cydgasglu Band Eang y Sector Cyhoeddus (PSBA) gan weithio mewn cydweithrediad â Llywodraeth Cymru a phartneriaid yn y sector preifat fel Logicalis a BT.

Hi sy wedi arwain, ar ran y Gwasanaeth TGCh, ar gyllid gan Lywodraeth Cymru ar gyfer Ysgolion. Mae hyn yn cynnwys grant Dysgu yn y Gymru Ddigidol gwerth £3.1 miliwn yn 2013 a chyllid Trawsnewid Technoleg Addysg gwerth £55 miliwn yn 2019 – nod y ddau oedd gwella isadeilledd y rhwydwaith (switshis rhwydwaith, pwyntiau mynediad di-wifr) a band eang mewn ysgolion i sicrhau bod rhwydweithiau ysgolion yn unol â safonau'r 21ain Ganrif. Mae cyllid Trawsnewid Technoleg Addysg hefyd wedi talu am ddyfeisiau newydd i ddisgyblion.

Ar ddechrau'r pandemig, roedd Elaine yn ganolog i waith y Gwasanaeth TGCh a Digidol ehangach o gyflwyno dyfeisiau i dros 3,000 o staff y Cyngor fel bod modd iddyn nhw weithio gartref, a hynny mewn cyfnod cymharol fyr. Bu hefyd yn arwain ar waith y Gwasanaeth TGCh, law yn llaw â'r Adran Addysg, o roi dyfeisiau i dros 5,000 o ddisgyblion wedi'u hallgau'n ddigidol er mwyn iddyn nhw ddysgu ar-lein o'u cartref.

Elaine Pritchard –

Head of ICT Operations, ICT & Digital Services – RCT

Elaine has worked her way up from a Grade 1 to Head of Service during her 35 years service within local government.

Her current role as Head of ICT Operations sees her overseeing 76 staff across the following areas – ICT Service Desk and Engineers, Technical Services (Infrastructure & Data Centre Services), Applications Team as well as Customer Engagement, Supplier & Account Management, ICT Managed Service and Business Contracts.

During her career she has been involved with the first introduction and rollout of the SIMS System to Schools across the former Mid Glamorgan County Council area back in 1993.

Elaine has represented RCT, informing the evolution of the All Wales Public Sector Broadband Network (PSBA) working in collaboration with Welsh Government and private sector partners such as Logicalis and BT.

She has taken a lead for ICT on Welsh Government funding for Schools such as the £3.1m Learning in Digital Wales (LiDW) grant in 2013 to the more recent 2019 £55m (all Wales) EdTech Transformation funding – both of which was to improve the network infrastructure (network switches, Wi-Fi Access Points) and broadband in schools to ensure schools networks were to 21st century standards. The EdTech Transformation funding has also allowed for new devices for pupils.

During the start of the pandemic, Elaine supported the process with the wider ICT & Digital Service on the roll out of devices to over 3000 Council users to be able to work from home in a relatively short period of time. She also took a lead for ICT with Education on equipping over 5000 digitally excluded pupils to be able to access on-line learning from home.
